Sanctioned strength of staff vis a vis men in position since 2000.

The Sanctioned Strength of the staff of Category-I, II, III & IV during 2000 was 73834 which have been reduced to 42038 as on 31.03.2018, which means that the Sanctioned Strength has been reduced by almost 31,000. The said reduction in Sanctioned Strength has been due to abolition of posts on account of Voluntary Retirement Scheme, due to Career Progression Scheme, Restructuring by Government of India. Against the MFP of 62430 in 2000 the MFP as on 31.03.2021 is only 22215 which is roughly 40000 less. The details are as under:
