EXTRAORDINARY CRIMINAL JURISDICTION**WRIT PETITION (CRIMINAL) No. /2025****SYNOPSIS**

The petitioner is approaching this Hon'ble Court seeking a thorough investigation by the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) into an incident dated 26/12/2023 wherein Late Dipankar Gogoi, a young youth, allegedly committed suicide after being unable to withstand police brutality, torture and humiliation for four days and threat of his implication in a false case at the end of the then superintendent of police of Jorhat, Mr Mohanlal Meena.

The deceased was taken into custody by police on 22/12/2023, 23/12/2023, 24/12/2023 and 25/12/2023 and was handed over to his parents after midnight. The deceased was always given a tube of ointment along with the medical examination advice slip when he was handed over to his parents at home. The deceased everyday narrated torture and physical beatings to his ailing aged parents. The deceased was not arrested formally.

On the morning of 26/12/2023, when the mother of the deceased didn't find him in his room, his parents started searching for him. While searching here and there, the father of the deceased found him hanging from a branch of a tree

in a tea garden behind their house. At around 7:00 am police were informed about the alleged suicide.

The Petitioner had seen that there were several injury marks on the legs, back and stomach on the dead body of the deceased.

Lackadaisical and botched up investigation by the state police.

An FIR was lodged by Ms Rimly Gogoi Saikia, the sister of the deceased and the petitioner herein at Titabar Police station which was registered as Titabar PS Case No. 132/2023, dated 27/12/2023, u/s 323/506/306 IPC against Mr Mohanlal Meena- R2, the then Superintendent of Police of Jorhat.

On 19/09/2024, the investigating officer filed the final report citing Mistake of Fact, even though there are prima facie evidences of third degree torture and the post mortem report which clearly showed external injury which were ante mortem.

The Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Titabar did not accept the final report and directed the police for re-investigation by appointing a senior rank police officer as investigating officer. However, the police appointed Sivasagar Superintendent of Police as the case investigating officer, flouting and violating the order of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate.

Need for an investigation by an independent agency.

A free & fair investigation demands that the investigating officer must be at least a rank senior to the rank of the prime

accused and that the investigation be conducted by a different investigating agency. It is unlikely that a junior or a same rank officer will investigate properly against their seniors or colleagues of the same department.

The Petitioner and her family do not have faith in the State police as the investigation in the present case has been conducted poorly and in a lackadaisical manner. Given that the accused in the present case are high-ranking police officials and there are material deficiencies and important pieces of evidence that have been overlooked by the state police, it is prayed that the present case be transferred to the Central Bureau of Investigation for a thorough investigation.

Hence, this petition.

- 21.12.2023 The deceased was called and questioned by police officers at Madhopur Police Out Post. He was let go after 2 hours of questioning.
- 22.12.2023 Titabar police takes into custody the deceased at around 3:00 pm from near his house and takes him to Titabar police station and interrogates him the whole time. He was handed over to his parents at home after midnight.
- 23.12.2023 Titabar & Jorhat Sadar police again takes the deceased into its illegal custody from his home at around 9:00 am and takes him to Jorhat Sadar police station where the accused police officers gives the deceased third degree torture and the Respondent- 2 puts his service pistol on the head of the deceased and threatens to implicate the deceased in a false case.
- 24.12.2023 Titabar & Jorhat Sadar police again takes the deceased into its illegal custody from his home at around 9:00 am. The deceased was taken to

Jorhat Sadar Police station and was tortured brutally. Respondent no. 2 tortured and again threatened to implicate the deceased in a false case. The deceased was also tortured at the official bungalow of the respondent no. 2.

25.12.2023

Titabar & Jorhat Sadar police again takes the deceased into its illegal custody from his home at around 9:00 am to the Jorhat Sadar Police station and gives third degree torture. Respondent No. 2 once again threatens to implicate the deceased in a false case by pointing the service pistol on the head of the deceased. The deceased was handed over to the family after midnight at around 2:30 am. Medical examination was not conducted on this day.

26.12.2023

The deceased allegedly commits suicide unable to bear the police brutality, torture and humiliation at the end of respondent no. 2.

27.12.2023

The petitioner herein lodges a First Information Report alleging abetment of suicide of her brother against

Respondent No. 2 at Titabar police station.

15.06.2024

The mother of the deceased petitions for legal aid before the District Legal Services Authority, Jorhat which forwarded the petition to Gauhati High Court Legal Services Committee, to provide legal aid to the family of the deceased. However, due to unknown reasons the petition couldn't be filed.

19.09.2024

The case investigating officer files the final report in the FIR before the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Titabar citing mistake of fact requesting closing of the case ignoring the facts and evidences which proved physical and mental torture of the deceased at the end of the Respondent No. 2.

03.12.2024

The learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Titabar did not accept the final report submitted by case investigating officer after perusing the post mortem report, protest petition and other documents and directed re-investigation and also directed the

police department to appoint a senior rank officer as investigating officer who shall be at least senior rank officer to a superintendent of Police.

18.01.2025

The petitioner and the mother of the deceased recorded their statements before the Assam Police Accountability Commission, Guwahati in the Suo Motu case no. 181/2023.

06.03.2025

Hence, the present writ petition.

The humble petition of the above named petitioner:

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

1. That the petitioner is a citizen of India and permanent resident of the above mentioned address in the state of Assam and as such she is entitled to all the rights and privileges guaranteed under the Constitution of India and laws framed there under.
2. That the Petitioner has filed the present Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India before this Hon'ble Court to issue an appropriate Writ or Order or a Direction to the Central Bureau of Investigation to take over the investigation of the Titabar PS Case No. 132/2023, dated 27/12/2023, u/s 323/506/306 IPC and submit and prosecute the guilty police officers who were involved in custodial torture leading to alleged suicide by the deceased late Dipankar Gogoi.
3. That the First Information Report (FIR) against the accused police personnel was lodged by Ms Rimly Gogoi Saikia



(petitioner), the sister of the deceased at Titabar Police station against the accused which was registered as Titabar PS Case No. 132/2023, dated 27/12/2023, u/s 323/506/306 IPC.

*True copy of the FIR lodged by the petitioner & registered as Titabar PS Case No. 132/2023, dated 27/12/2023; u/s 323/506/306 IPC is annexed as **ANNEXURE- P1**.*

4. That the petitioner states that the father of the deceased, Mr Khagen Gogoi is about 68 years old and her mother Mrs. Dipti Gogoi is about 59 years old. There are two sisters namely Ms. Rimly Gogoi Saikia (petitioner herein) and Ms. Seema Gogoi Bora.
5. It is clarified that since one of the relief sought in the present petition is for investigation and criminal action against the accused police personnel and the nature of this writ petition is criminal and hence the same has been filed as criminal writ petition.
6. That the respondent no. 1 is the State of Assam, through Home Secretary which is the controlling department of the Assam police. Respondent no. 2 was the superintendent of police of Jorhat district at the time of the incident and is the prime accused in the subject FIR. Respondent no. 3 is the Sub-Divisional Police Officer of Titabar. Respondent no. 4 is the officer-in-charge of the Titabar police station and was



directly involved in torture of the deceased. Respondent no. 5 is the case investigating officer of the subject FIR.

7. THE CASE IN BRIEF

A. That on 22/12/2023 Titabar police forcefully took into custody Late Dipankar Gogoi, aged about 23 years then, without any reason while he was on his way to a nearby store to buy some groceries for his home at around 3:30 pm. While in police custody he was interrogated with regard to a bomb blast which took place at Lichubari of Jorhat on 14/12/2023. The deceased who didn't have an iota of knowledge about the blast had pleaded innocence consistently. After he was handed over to his parents at home at around 2:30 am on 23/12/2023 the deceased narrated to his parents that he was taken into custody and interrogated by Titabar police and was kept at the police station the whole time.

B. That on 23/12/2023 the deceased was again taken into custody from his home by Titabar and Jorhat Sadar Police at around 9:00 am and was taken to Jorhat Sadar Police Station where he was tortured and brutally beaten by police personnel. Respondent No- 2 pointed his service pistol on the head of the deceased and threatened and pressurized him to confess and take responsibility for the bomb blast which took place in Lichubari of Jorhat on 14/12/2023. The deceased who



didn't have an iota of knowledge about the blast had pleaded innocence consistently. The deceased was threatened & pressurized by Respondent No- 2 that if he doesn't accept the responsibility of the blast, then he will be killed in a fake police encounter. The deceased was also taken and tortured at the official residence of the Respondent no. 2. The deceased was handed over to his parents at home after midnight along with a tube of ointment and medical examination advice slip. The deceased narrated the ordeal and showed the injury marks on his body to his mother.

C. That on 24/12/2023 the deceased was again taken into custody by Titabar and Jorhat Sadar Police from his home at 9:00 am and was tortured the whole time at Jorhat Sadar Police station. The deceased was again tortured by Respondent no 2. He was given a tube of ointment along with the medical examination advice slip when he was handed over to his parents at home after midnight. The deceased narrated torture and physical beatings to his ailing aged parents.

D. That on 25/12/2023 the deceased was again taken into custody from his home at around 9:00 am by Titabar and Jorhat Sadar Police and was handed over to his parents at around 2:30 am on 26/12/2023. His parents found him very weak on that day in comparison to other days. The deceased carried with him the tube of ointment provided by the police and entered the home



dragging his feet and unnaturally putting his head over the lap of his mother and started crying and said, "Mother, the police have badly beaten me up and I can no longer bear it. Today I was told by the Superintendent of Police at gunpoint that if I do not confess to being involved in the Jorhat bomb blast case, he will shoot me to death tomorrow." Both of the parents told the deceased that as he didn't do anything wrong, nothing will happen. Deceased's mother tried to feed him food but he couldn't eat properly as he was very weak and while crying he said that he was not involved in any illegal/criminal activity and his dream of joining the police and other services are being shattered as he will be killed by Respondent No- 2. Mother of the deceased made him sleep after making him understand that nothing wrong will happen to him. Deceased also stated that the Respondent No. 2 is coming to their home in order to kill them all.

E. That on 26/12/2023, when the mother of the deceased didn't find him in his room in the morning, both the parents started searching for him. After sometime when the deceased was not found, an FIR was filed at Madhopur Police Out Post by the father, but was not registered by the police. After coming back from the Madhopur Police outpost, while searching here and there, the father of the deceased found him hanging from a branch of a tree in a tea garden behind their



house. At around 7:00 am police were informed about the hanging. Shockingly, after five hours, Titabar Sub-Divisional Police Officer along with a large contingent of police personnel came and without meeting any family members went directly to the place of the incident. After some time, the executive Magistrate arrived and the dead body was taken down from the tree. The police didn't allow anybody to see the dead body, however the petitioner forcefully with the intervention of the villagers saw the dead body of her brother and found that there were several injury marks on the legs, back and stomach.

F. That the deceased was taken into custody by police on 22/12/2023, 23/12/2023, 24/12/2023 and 25/12/2023 and was always handed over to his parents at home after midnight by Titabar police led by Respondent No. 4 and the mother of the deceased was made to sign a document when he was handed over. However, on the intervening night of 25/12/2023 & 26/12/2023 signature of the mother of the deceased was not taken by Respondent no. 4. The deceased everyday narrated torture and physical beating to his parents.

G. That the deceased was always given tubes of ointment when he was handed over to his parents. On two days medical examination advice slips were also given. Medical examination of the deceased during custody was done only on 23/12/2023 and 24/12/2023 at



Titabar Sub-Divisional Civil Hospital. It is submitted that the name of the deceased is wrongly written on the medical examination slip of 23/12/2023 as Dipankar Das. It is further submitted that on the medical examination slip of 24/12/2023 the time is mentioned as 7:28 pm, however the deceased was handed over to his parents after midnight only. The deceased was not medically examined on 25/12/2023. The doctors who have conducted the medical examination were never examined by the case investigating officer.

*True copies of the medical examination advice slips dated 23/12/2023 and 24/12/2023 conducted at Titabar Sub Divisional Civil Hospital and photograph of the tubes of ointment which were given by police to the deceased at the time of handing over him to his parents are annexed as **ANNEXURE- P2 (Colly)**.*

H. That the post mortem report of the deceased clearly proved the injuries to be of ante mortem. It mentioned that there are i) Bruise bluish black in color present over the left buttock of size measuring 9 cm x 5 cm and ii) Bruise bluish black in color present over the right buttock of size measuring 14 cm x 9 cm which are ante mortem and were caused by blunt force impact. It is submitted that the investigating officer didn't take the post mortem report into consideration. The investigating officer also didn't take the statement of



the doctor who performed the post mortem. The forensic report has also not been provided to the family of the deceased.

*True certified copy of the Post Mortem report of the deceased is annexed as **ANNEXURE- P3.***

- I. That on 19/09/2024, the investigating officer filed a case closure report vide Final Report no 12/2024 citing Mistake of Fact, though there were prima facie evidence of torture and brutality and also post mortem report which proved custodial torture. The final report did not mention the torture of the deceased at Jorhat Sadar Police station and at the official residence of the Respondent No. 2. It also shows that the investigating officer did not investigate the other accused's who were named in their statements by the informants and witnesses.

*True certified copy of the Final Report submitted by the investigation officer before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate vide final report no 12/2024, dated 19/09/2024 is annexed as **ANNEXURE- P4.***



- J. That on 03/12/2024, the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Titabar ordered for re-investigation of the case after perusing the final report filed by the police in the subject FIR and other documents connected with

the case including the post mortem report and the protest petition. Learned SDJM further opined and directed that considering the rank and file of the accused persons in this case, and for ensuring public confidence, accountability, transparency, this case must be re-investigated by a senior rank police officer who will be selected by the present Superintendent of Police, Jorhat.

True certified copy of the order of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate dated 03/12/2023 is annexed as ANNEXURE- P5.

- K. That while the deceased was in police custody, the Respondent No- 2, Respondent No- 3 and other police personnel searched and reced the surroundings of the house of the deceased. The mobile phone of the mother of the deceased was seized and also took away job related documents of the deceased. The mobile phone of the mother has not been returned till date and the family was never given a seizure list.

- L. That the Respondent No. 4 forcefully offered Rs 5000/- in cash to the deceased's family to cremate the deceased immediately upon arrival. However, the family didn't accept the amount.



- M. That the deceased was never arrested formally and was always handed over to his parents before completion of 24 hours of custody.

- N. That on 21/12/2023 the deceased was also called for questioning by police officers of Madhopur police out post and was let go home after 2 hours.

- O. That the respondent no. 2 tortured and pressured the deceased to self-implicate in a false case. The deceased was threatened that if he doesn't self-implicate in a false case he will be killed in a fake encounter.

- P. That the torture and physical beatings was too much that the deceased several times said to his parents that he doesn't want to live anymore as his dream of joining police services are being shattered.

- Q. That the deceased was keen and interested in getting a job at the police department and at various other union para military forces and had applied for several jobs and appeared for interview. The deceased had been physically training himself for fitness for several years.

*True copy of the job applications and admit cards which the deceased applied to various departments and which are available are annexed as **ANNEXURE- P6 (Colly)**.*



R. That the deceased had secured a job at Numaligarh and had himself medically tested on 16/12/2023 from SDMO (Ayur), Titabar BPHC, Jorhat for a medical fitness certificate which was to be submitted to the employer.

*True copy of the medical fitness certificate issued to the deceased by SDMO (Ayur), Titabar BPHC dated 16/12/2023 is annexed as **ANNEXURE- P7.***

S. It is submitted that it was not possible for the deceased to put the rope across the branch of the tree and tie it to the tree. The branch which was used to tie the rope is more than 11 feet high above the ground. As the deceased was given third degree torture by the accused police personnel and he couldn't walk & stand properly it is unlikely that the deceased could have thrown the rope over the branch and tie the rope.

*Photograph of the alleged suicide where the height of the branch of the tree can be seen is annexed as **ANNEXURE- P8.***



T. That the mother of the deceased had petitioned for legal aid in the month of June, 2024 before the District Legal Services Authority, Jorhat who in turn forwarded the application to Gauhati High Court Legal Services Committee (Principal Seat), vide Memo No. DLSA(J)/2849/2024 on 18/06/2024 to provide legal aid

to the family of the deceased. The Gauhati High Court Legal Services Committee through memo no. GHCLSC-118/2024/562-564, dated 25/06/2024 engaged counsel for legal aid, but due to unknown reasons the petition couldn't be filed.

*True copies of the memos of DLSA & GHCLSC, dated 18/06/2024 & 25/06/2024 respectively are annexed as **ANNEXURE-P9 (Colly)**.*

U. That on 18/01/2025 the petitioner and the mother of the deceased have also recorded their statements before the Assam Police Accountability Commission, Guwahati in the suo motu case no. 181/2023. It is submitted that the commission didn't record the statements of the witnesses properly. Some of the facts which were narrated by the witnesses (Petitioner & the mother of the deceased) were not recorded in the statements; however they were made to sign the statements which were in English.

*True copies of the statements of the petitioner and the mother of the deceased before the Assam Police Accountability Commission dated 18/01/2025 are annexed as **ANNEXURE- P10 (colly)**.*

V. That sub inspector Nirupama Das was appointed case investigating officer initially by Respondent No. 4 and



had taken statements from the witnesses, but the Final Report has been submitted by Inspector Miraj Doley. The change in investigating officer was never intimated to the informant/petitioner. It is pertinent to mention that the Final Report was forwarded by Lakshman Kr. Das, the officer-in-charge of the Titabar Police Station who himself is an accused and Respondent No. 4. It is further submitted that inspector Miraj Doley didn't do any investigation nor took statements and evidences afresh after he took over the investigation of the case from the previous investigating officer.

W. That the prime accused is the then Superintendent of Police of the Jorhat District and the investigating officer was of the sub inspector rank initially and later on inspector rank which is much junior to the prime accused in the subject FIR. A free & fair investigation demands that the investigating officer in the subject FIR must be at least a rank senior to the rank of the prime accused in the subject FIR and the investigation be done by a different investigating body. It is unlikely that a junior rank officer will investigate properly against his seniors in the same department.



X. That the investigation has been conducted in the subject FIR in a shoddy manner and there are material deficiencies as well as important pieces of evidence which have been overlooked. The informants &

witnesses had accused other police officers as well in their statements before the investigating officer who were not named in the subject FIR, but the investigating officer didn't interrogate the accused nor made any arrests. It is imperative that the accused police persons are using their clout in obstructing the investigation.

Y. That the deceased's family doesn't have faith in the Assam Police as they are doing the investigation in a lackadaisical & botched up manner; therefore the petitioner craves this Hon'ble Court for an investigation by the Central Bureau of Investigation.

8. **GROUND:**

The Petitioner herein is approaching this Hon'ble Court under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia* on the following grounds: -

A. BECAUSE there is a clear violation of Human and Fundamental Rights of the deceased and his family and police pressure to self-implicate the deceased in a different case.

B. BECAUSE the accused in the present case are high-ranking police officials and there are material deficiencies and important pieces of evidence that have been overlooked by the state police.



C. BECAUSE even after the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate ordered re-investigation by a senior rank officer, the police department didn't appoint a senior rank officer as an investigating officer and instead appointed a Superintendent of Police of a different district.

D. BECAUSE even after the post-mortem report clearly showed that there was third degree torture on the deceased, the investigating officer ignored that report and submitted the final report citing a mistake of fact and it is unlikely that the investigating officer will ever take it into consideration.

E. BECAUSE the informant & witnesses in their statements before the case investigating officer provided the photograph of the dead body of the deceased which showed several injury marks as evidence. However, the investigating officer didn't take the evidence provided into consideration.

F. BECAUSE the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***D.K. Basu v. State of W.B., (1997) 1 SCC 416*** held:

9. The importance of affirmed rights of every human being needs no emphasis and, therefore, to deter breaches thereof becomes a sacred duty of the Court, as the custodian and protector of the fundamental and the basic human rights of the citizens. Custodial violence, including



torture and death in the lock-ups, strikes a blow at the rule of law, which demands that the powers of the executive should not only be derived from law but also that the same should be limited by law. Custodial violence is a matter of concern. It is aggravated by the fact that it is committed by persons who are supposed to be the protectors of the citizens. It is committed under the shield of uniform and authority in the four walls of a police station or lock-up, the deceased being totally helpless. The protection of an individual from torture and abuse by the police and other law-enforcing officers is a matter of deep concern in a free society. These petitions raise important issues concerning police powers, including whether monetary compensation should be awarded for established infringement of the Fundamental Rights guaranteed by Articles 21 and 22 of the Constitution of India. The issues are fundamental.

17. Fundamental Rights occupy a place of pride in the Indian Constitution. Article 21 provides "no person shall be deprived of his life or personal liberty except according to procedure established by law". Personal liberty, thus, is a sacred and cherished right under the Constitution. The expression "life or personal liberty" has been held to include the right to live with human dignity and thus it would also include within itself a guarantee against torture and assault by the State or its functionaries. Article 22 guarantees protection against arrest and detention in certain cases and declares that no person who is arrested shall be



detained in custody without being informed of the grounds of such arrest and he shall not be denied the right to consult and defend himself by a legal practitioner of his choice. Clause (2) of Article 22 directs that the person arrested and detained in custody shall be produced before the nearest Magistrate within a period of 24 hours of such arrest, excluding the time necessary for the journey from the place of arrest to the Court of the Magistrate. Article 20(3) of the Constitution lays down that a person accused of an offence shall not be compelled to be a witness against himself. These are some of the constitutional safeguards provided to a person with a view to protect his personal liberty against any unjustified assault by the State. In tune with the constitutional guarantee a number of statutory provisions also seek to protect personal liberty, dignity and basic human rights of the citizens. Chapter V of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 deals with the powers or arrest of a person and the safeguards which are required to be followed by the police to protect the interest of the arrested person. Section 41 CrPC confers powers on any police officer to arrest a person under the circumstances specified therein without any order or a warrant of arrest from a Magistrate. Section 46 provides the method and manner of arrest. Under this section no formality is necessary while arresting a person. Under Section 49, the police is not permitted to use more restraint than is necessary to prevent the escape of the person. Section 50 enjoins every police officer arresting any person without warrant to



communicate to him the full particulars of the offence for which he is arrested and the grounds for such arrest. The police officer is further enjoined to inform the person arrested that he is entitled to be released on bail and he may arrange for sureties in the event of his arrest for a non-bailable offence. Section 56 contains a mandatory provision requiring the police officer making an arrest without warrant to produce the arrested person before a Magistrate without unnecessary delay and Section 57 echoes clause (2) of Article 22 of the Constitution of India. There are some other provisions also like Sections 53, 54 and 167 which are aimed at affording procedural safeguards to a person arrested by the police. Whenever a person dies in custody of the police, Section 176 requires the Magistrate to hold an enquiry into the cause of death.

G. BECAUSE in ***R.S. Sodhi v. State of U.P. [R.S. Sodhi v. State of U.P., (1994) Supp (1) SCC 143***, the Hon'ble Supreme Court held:

"2. ... we think that since the accusations are directed against the local police personnel it would be desirable to entrust the investigation to an independent agency like the Central Bureau of Investigation so that all concerned including the relatives of the deceased may feel assured that an independent agency is looking into the matter and that would lend the final outcome of the investigation credibility.



However faithfully the local police may carry out the investigation, the same will lack credibility since the allegations are against them."

(Emphasis supplied)

H. BECAUSE the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Bharati Tamang v. Union of India, (2013) 15 SCC 578*** held:

41.3. *If deficiency in investigation or prosecution is visible or can be perceived by lifting the veil which tries to hide the realities or covering the obvious deficiency, Courts have to deal with the same with an iron hand appropriately within the framework of law.*

41.4. *It is as much the duty of the prosecutor as of the Court to ensure that full and material facts are brought on record so that there might not be miscarriage of justice.*

41.5. *In order to ensure that the criminal prosecution is carried on without any deficiency, in appropriate cases this Court can even constitute Special Investigation Team and also give appropriate directions to the Central and State Governments and other authorities to give all required assistance to such specially constituted investigating team in order to book*



the real culprits and for effective conduct of the prosecution.

41.7. In appropriate cases even if the charge-sheet is filed it is open for this Court or even for the High Court to direct investigation of the case to be handed over to CBI or to any other independent agency in order to do complete justice.

41.8. In exceptional circumstances the Court in order to prevent miscarriage of criminal justice and if considered necessary may direct for investigation de novo.

I. BECAUSE the petitioner and her family have lost faith in the police department due to their lackadaisical approach in investigation and it is also feared that they might not investigate their own people.

J. BECAUSE a fair investigation is crucial for a free & fair trial and in this subject FIR, investigation has been done in a lackadaisical & in a botched up way in order to shield the officers involved in the crime.

K. BECAUSE there is a clear chance of destroying the evidences available against the respondent police personnel who were involved in the brutal torture of the deceased, it is therefore, this Hon'ble Court may restrain



the concerned respondent police personnel from respective official duties till the disposal of this case and till the completion of the independent investigation.

L. BECAUSE of the aforesaid, facts, circumstances and grounds, this Hon'ble Court may be please to order for an independent investigation against the police personnel who were involved in the torture of the deceased shall be conducted by Central Bureau of Investigation under the supervision of this Hon'ble Court and get the concerned police personnel be brought before the law.

9. The Petitioner herein craves the liberty of this Court to add, alter, modify or amend the grounds during the pendency of this Petition, if necessary.
10. The Petitioner herein states that she has not filed a similar Writ Petition or any other petition before this Hon'ble Court or any other Court/s involving the subject matter of this petition, which is pending or has been disposed of.
11. This Hon'ble Court has the jurisdiction to entertain the present Petition.
12. That the annexures filed with the petition are a true copy of the respective originals.



13. That the petitioner submits that in view of the facts and circumstances stated above it is a fit case wherein your lordships would be pleased to pass direction as has been prayed for, failing which the rights of the deceased and his family would be violated.
14. That this petition is filed bonafide and in the interest of justice.

PRAYER

It is, therefore, under the facts and circumstances of the present case most humbly prayed, that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to:

1. Issue an appropriate Writ or Order or Direction calling for records of the case and commanding the Central Bureau of Investigation to take over the investigation of the Titabar PS. Case No. 132/2023 and submit and prosecute the guilty police officers who were involved in custodial torture to the Petitioner's brother leading to his death by alleged suicide; and
2. Issue an appropriate writ or order or direction to monitor/supervise the investigation by Hon'ble Judge of this Court, into the custodial torture meted out to the Petitioner's brother leading to his death by alleged suicide; and



3. Issue an appropriate writ or order or direction commanding the Respondent-State to award adequate compensation to the deceased's family for violating the Fundamental and Human Rights of the deceased and his family members; and/or
4. Pass such other and further orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.

And for this act of kindness, the Petitioner as in duty bound shall ever pray.

Sir,

I have the honour to state that around 3:30 p.m. on 22nd December, when my younger brother Dipankar Gogoi, the only son of Sri Khagen Gogoi (father) and Dipti Gogoi (mother), R/o Garikuri under Titabar Sub-Division in the District of Jorhat, was going to a shop to purchase potato, police of Titabar Police Station picked him up from the road and left him at home around 2:30 a.m. that day itself. As has been stated by my younger brother to the family, he was brought by the police Titabar Police Station to Jorhat Sadar Police Station where Mohanlal Meena, the Superintendent of Police of Jorhat District questioned him at gunpoint about the bomb blast that took place in the premises of the Army Cantonment at Lichubari of Jorhat town on 14th December and pressurised him to confess his involvement in the bomb blast. My brother was shocked and as he denied this, he was assaulted on various parts of his body and a threat was made to him that if he did not make a confessional statement as the Superintendent of Police had said, he would be shot to death. My younger brother narrated the whole incident to my parents in tears while holding an ointment for pain and a

prescription. Again on 23rd, 24th and 25th December, he was taken away during the morning hours and was released sometimes in the middle of the night and sometimes at dawn. He was assaulted and sent back with an ointment and a medical observation slip by the doctor of Titabar Sub-Divisional Civil Hospital like the day one and every day my younger brother informed my parents about the unspeakable torture meted out to him by the police, while crying. My younger brother was subjected to so much physical and mental torture that he broke down before my parents saying he could no longer live. He got emotional by saying that he was doing physical exercises in morning and evening to join the police or army; that he applied for a job at the Numaligarh refinery and that all of his dreams were over. Like in the previous four days, around 9 a.m. on 25th December, a police team from Titabar and Jorhat picked up my younger brother from home and left him at the gateway to the house at night. That day, compared to the other day, my parents found him in a state of utter exhaustion. Like the other day, with an ointment for pain in his hand, he came inside the house limping, and cried his heart out putting his head on the lap of my mother, in such terms, "Mother, the police have badly beaten me up and I can no longer bear it. Today I was told by the Superintendent of Police at gunpoint that if I do not confess to being involved in the Jorhat bomb blast case, he will shoot me to death tomorrow." My parents told my younger brother that since he was innocent, God was with us and consoled him by saying that we were passing through a bad phase of our lives. My mother tried to feed

him some rice by putting her hand on his head but he cried out under the body pain and mental shock and swore before my mother in such terms, "Mother, I am innocent. I wanted to fulfill my dreams. I wanted to take up a job in the police but they would kill me. Saying this, he got exhausted and my mother consoled him and put him to sleep. In the morning on 26th December, when the mother went to see my younger brother, she did not find him on the bed and as she told my father and my younger brother was not available on the bed, he was searched for. As he was not found, an ejahar was lodged with Madhapur Police Out-Post. My father returned home and upon searching for him, my father saw him hanging from a tree in the garden behind our house. My father then informed the police around 7 a.m. It is a matter of regret that even after informing the police, a large police team including the Titabar Sub-Divisional Police Officer arrived about five hours late and left for the spot without meeting any of the family members. After some time, in the presence of the magistrate, the body of the brother was lowered down by cutting the rope, but astonishingly the police did not allow my younger brother's dead body to be seen by any family member or relative. But when I myself forcibly opened the rope with which the dead body was tied, I could clearly see marks of injury on his stomach, back and legs.

That it is not just suicide, it is a planned murder. My younger brother was forced to take this route by subjecting him to inhumane physical and mental torture merely on the

basis of suspicion and without any evidence. So we, the family, seek justice. I request you to identify the guilty policemen who have subjected my younger brother to inhuman and heinous physical and mental tortures, through a fair and proper investigation and to ensure stricter punishment to them. No guilty person should be spared. We hope you will do justice to our family by taking special measures in this regard.

He was compel to suicide. Hence the case.

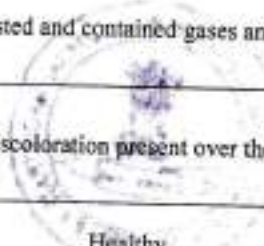

16. Brief facts / background of the case (Separate Sheet to be attached)

The Brief of the Case :-On 27/12/2023 complainant Rimlee Saikia lodged an FIR stating that on 22/12/2023 her brother Dipankar Gogoi was picked by Titabar police on suspect to interrogate in connection with the Lichubari bomb blast case .The said Dipankar Gogoi was interrogated,pressurized him physically and mentally by the SP jorhat and other police personnel of Jorhat and handed over to the family members.Likewise on 23/12/2023,24/12/2023,24/12/2023 and 25/12/2023 he was picked up by OC Titabar PS and interrogated hi different PS of Jorhat and Titabar causing him mental and physical torture everyday and handed over to the family members during the night hours.On 26/12/2023 he was found missing from his residence and later on he was found hanging behind their house in a tree. Accordingly the matter was informed at Madhapur OP and Titabar PS.Hence the case.

17. Facts disclosed during investigation (Separate Sheet to be attached)

During investigation the PO of the case was visited and the complainant & available witnesses were examined in connection with the Case.During investigation prior to the registration of the case on receiving information about the death of victim Dipankar gogoi the PO of the case was visited and Inquest of the deadbody of deceased was conducted by ex-magistrate in presence of witnesses and was sent for post-mortem examination at JMCH .The whole process was videographed.During the course of investigation alleged accused persons were examined and it was revealed that victim of this instant case was a suspect of Bomb blast at Jorhat on 14/12/2023 and so he was brought totitabar PS for interrogation for four days and was handed over to his family members everyday after thorough medical checkup and medical report suggest that there were no any injury in the body of the victim during that period.However the complainant could not produce any ointment or medicine which victim showed to as per thei allegation.further during investigation the viscera of the victim's deadbody was sent for FSL examination and after collection of the report the final Post Mortem report was collected from the Dept. of Forensic Medicine JMCH where the concerned medical officer opined that "Death was due to asphyxia as a result of antemortem hanging which was suicidal in nature".During the course of investigation the CCTV footage of the Police Station was examined and no any incriminating materials found against the alleged accused persons in the footages.Moreover it has come to light in the course of investigation that the victim might have received threat from banned organization as per statement of witness.So considering the above facts and circumstances it is revealed that complainant lodged the FIR at Titabar PS against the alleged persons only out of anger and grief of the death of her deceased brother. Hence, I have submitted the final report of the case U/S 306/323/506 I.P.C to your Hon'ble Court as mistake of fact and pray before your Hon'ble Court to approve the same.The result of investigation has been informed to the complainant through notice.

(mid night) to his house and then victim narrated to his parents that he was taken to Jorhat P.S. where the then S.P. of Jorhat Mohan Lal Meena (accused no. 1) pointed his service revolver to his head and forced him to confess and to take responsibility for bomb blast which occurred in Lichubari on 14th December, 2023. 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responsibility of the blast then he would be encountered. It is mentioned that police also gave him some medicines and ointment. Similarly, on 23rd, 24th, and 25th December, 2023 the victim was picked up in the morning and dropped back at midnight and was assaulted at the police station. The torture was so grave that victim told his parents that he would never join police force though it was his dream job. On 25.12.2023, he was picked up at around 9:00 A.M. by some police personnel and dropped back on following day early morning and he was found very weak and was carrying ointment and entered his home dragging his feet and unnaturally putting his head over the lap of his mother and started crying and expressed that police had beaten him badly and he was not able to tolerate anymore. It is also mentioned that accused no. 1 again put his pistol on his head and forced him take responsibility for the bomb blast else he would be shot dead. The victim was consoled by his parents that nothing would happen and forced him to take food he was not able to eat properly and while crying he expressed that his dream of joining police force and other service being shattered as he would be killed by accused no. 1. The victim was made fall sleep by his mother on 26.12.2023 at morning when

his mother failed to find him in his room and they started to search and after sometime one written complaint regarding his missing was lodged at Madhapur Outpost by his father and when his father returned from the Outpost, he found victim hanged himself to a tree backside of the garden of their house. On the same day, at around 7:00 A.M., police was informed but after around 5 hours SDPO, Titabar, Kakoli Patgiri (accused no. 2) along with large contingent of police personnel came and without meeting family members of the victim went to place of incident. After some time, Magistrate arrived and dead body was taken from the tree, but police did not allow anybody to see the dead body and when the Informant forcefully saw the dead body she saw several injury marks on his leg, back and stomach which were apparent and one video is also available.

On 27th December, 2023, she lodged this case and O/C, Titabar P.S., Lakshman Kumar Das (accused no. 3) registered this case under sections 323/506/306 I.P.C. and entrusted Nirupama Das to investigate the case. The I.O. after due investigation on 19.09.2024 filed Final Report (F.R.) closure report citing mistake of fact. It is mentioned in the protest petition that the prime accused in this case is Superintendent of Police and Investigation

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Officer is a Sub-Inspector Rank Officer, who is much junior to the prime accused and for fair investigation the Investigation Officer must be superior to the prime accused in this case and for that matter an investigation by different police stations or by CID may be conducted as it is unlikely that junior rank officer will investigate the case properly against her senior in the Department. It is further mentioned that Sub-Inspector Nirupama Das recorded statements of witnesses, but Final Report was submitted by Miraj Doley and same was forwarded by accused no. 3. It is also mentioned that the Investigating Officer did not take into consideration report of Post-Mortem Report, where following injuries are mentioned:

- (i) Bruise bluish in colour present over the left buttock of size measuring 9cmx5cm
- (ii) Bruise bluish black in colour present over the right buttock of size measuring 14cmx9cm which are ante-mortem and were caused by blunt force impact.

The Medical Officer, who conducted the Post-Mortem and the Doctor, who examined the victim at SDCH, Titabar, were not examined by the I.O. Therefore, Informant prays before this Court that for

the interest of justice, equity and fair play to accept the protest petition and take cognizance against the Final Report and issue summon to the accused persons.

Heard Ld. Counsel of Informant, who orally submitted that the Informant being elder sister of the victim moving pillar to post only to secure justice for her deceased brother who was mercilessly beaten by the accused persons on false charge of planting bomb at Lichubari without being registering any case against him and he was detained without due procedures and only to save their face they used to release him mainly earlier morning before completion of 24 hours of detention and providing him with medicines, which shows that he was beaten mercilessly. She further argues that the present case is an example of police high-handedness and because of that victim was compelled to take his own life. The accused persons are directly involved and sole reasons for victim to take his own life. Therefore, Ld. Counsel further prays to take necessary action against the accused persons.

This Court has meticulously perused the protest petition, FIR and other documents connected with this case including the Post-Mortem Report.

According to **Bhagwat Singh Vs. Commissioner of Police AIR 1985 SC 1285**, this Court has three options i.e. (i) accept the report and drop the proceeding or (ii) disagree with the report and taking the view that there are sufficient grounds for proceeding to take cognizance of offence and issue process or (iii) may direct further investigation to be made by the I.O. of this case.

It is to be remind that the fair investigation only can ensure fair trial, which is constitutional right, hence it solemn duty of the I.O. to conduct fair and just investigation and in a democratic set-up if the cry of the victim is not fairly heard, then the whole façade of democratic polity will collapse. In this case, the importance of perception of justice is also very critical as accused persons are senior police officers having administrative control over the Investigating Officer which actually dent the perception of fair investigation. It is common principle that justice must not only be done must also been seen to be done, which clearly indicates the importance of fairness, transparency and public confidence in the investigation of any case and if any investigation is not done with visible

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fairness then the public trust in the police administration will surely deteriorate leading to social instability.

Therefore, considering the protest petition, FIR, other documents, submissions of Ld. Counsel of Informant and rank and file of the accused persons in this case, this Court is of the opinion that for ensuring public confidence, accountability, transparency, this case must be re-investigated by a senior police personnel who will be selected by the present Superintendent of Police, Jorhat and who shall investigate the case without fair and favour following the constitutional morality and oath which was taken at the time of joining the service.

Accordingly, the petition no. 220/24 is allowed and disposed of accordingly.



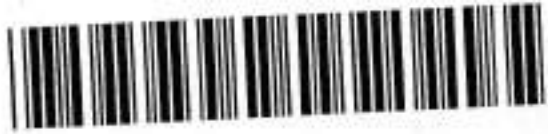

To-day, I have appeared before the Commission and depose as below.

On 26.12.2023 at about 6:00 Am I received an information from my mother over phone that my elder brother Dipankar Gogoi who was handed over by police during night time at our home in not present in his bed and not traceable. At that time I was at my father -in-laws house located at Sivasagar, Namti. Receiving the information I proceed to my mothers house, Birinahai, Gariguri gaon. I arrived home at 11:00 Am and seen that the family members are crying / weeping and my mother was already admitted at Hospital. I got the information that my brother Dipankar Gogoi committed suicide by hanging in a tree behind our house. He was brought down and was packed with a Dhari and was lying down on the ground. I wanted to see the face of my brother by police , but the local villagers interfered and allowed to see my brother body and face and I found some marks of assault on his whole body in the face, in the buttock and backside and took photographs by the people and given to me which I have produced before SPAC. Thereafter the dead body was taken to JMCH for PM examination. After PM examination is over the dead body was handed over to us at 7:00 PM. I protested not to accept the dead body as police have assaulted him and for which he may commit suicide to save from the in human atrocities of police. I also demanded the presence of SP, Jorhat for whose action my brother had to commit suicide. He was totally innocent not involving any alleged bomb blast case. He was interrogated by police for several days and forced him to confessed his involvement which he denied and assaulted him inhumanly.

It is to be mentioned that OC Titabor PS Lakhman Kr. Das forcefully offered Rs. 5000/- to us to burn the dead body early, but we did not accept. I like to mention that my brother was picked up by Titabor PS on 22.12.2023 and thereafter daily he was interrogated by police at different PS like Titabor, Jorhat and SP banglaw etc. causing hi physical and mental assault and forced him to confessed his guilt, but he denied. From that day to 26.12.2023 he was daily picked up by police interrogated him for the whole day and night and daily handed over to us doing some medical examination and again picked up daily for severe interrogation. Nothing could be detected from him for which he was not arrested and forwarded to jail. My question is if he was involved in ULFA related case why he was arrested and forwarded to jail. If would have been done my brother could not have committed suicide. He was forced to say that he planted the bomb otherwise he would be killed doing encounter. Due to the physical and mental torture (inhuman and unbearable) my brother Dipankar Gogoi the innocent boy committed suicide. For the entire incident killing / death of my brother SP Mohan Lal Mina IPS, OC Titabor PS, SDPO Kakali Patgiri, APS were the behind the incident. For which my brother committed suicide. For the said incident I filed an FIR at Titabor PS against the above noted officers which was registered vide Titabor PS case No. 132/2023 U/S 306/323/506 IPC which was investigated by WSI(P) Nirupama Das. The case was submitted in FR as mistake of fact which I have not accepted and informed the matter in the Court and protested the investigation of the case. Court have ordered for re-investigation of the case by senior officer and now under re-investigation.

Q. No. 1:- why your brother Dipankar Gogoin had to commit suicide ?

Ans- My brother Dipnakar Gogoi had to commit suicide as police have picked up him daily to interrogate in a false case and did unbearable and inhuman torture both physical and mental since 22.12.2023 to 23.12.2023 in different PSs, Titabor PS, Jorhat PS, SPs Banglow etc. in police custody without any case against him for which he was bound to commit suicide. If he would have been arrested in a case and forwarded to jail, he could not have commit suicide. He was the only earning member of family and was looking after the old aged ailing parents.

Q. No. 2:- Your allegation is against whom ?

Ans- My allegation is against SP Mohon Lal. Meena, IPS, SDPO Kakali Patgiri and OC Lakhman Kr. Das of Titabor PS who assaulted my brother daily in the PSs of Jorhat Dist. and caused physical and mental injury and I want justice and to take steps against the police officers.

To-day, I have appeared before the Commission and depose as below.

I reside at Birinahai Gariguri Gaon with my husband and my son Dipankar Gogoi. My son Dipankar Gogoi do cultivation and other house hold works and look after us as we are ill aged parents on 22.12.2023 my son was picked up by police at about 3:00 Pm while he went for marketing. On the same night at about 12:00 Am (night) he was handed over by Titabor Police stating that he was taken to the PS for getting some information about a case. That day he was not assaulted by police as my son stated. From 23.12.2023 to 26.12.2023 he was always picked up by police daily in the morning and hand over to us during night time. During these days the police party assaulted my son at Titabor PS, Jorhat PS and Jorhat SP Banglow in police custody by SP himself and other police party. He was forced to confess his involvement in a bomb blast case which he denied for which he was severely bitten up and given inhuman torture and got injury. On 23.12.2023 my son was handed over by police at about 2:00 Am. That day he was bitten up severely and shown me his injury marks in his buttock, back side, in his chest and other parts which was not bearable by him. He stated that police will kill him and our family members if not confessed that he planted the bomb. Therefore he was assaulted daily and finding no alternate he committed suicide in the early morning of 26.12.2023 by hanging in a tree behind our residence.

It is to be mentioned that my son Dipnakar Gogoi was found missing in his bed and not traceable in the morning and was informed to all the neibours and in the PS Titabor, later on after search his body was found hanging in a tree behind our residence and spread the information all over. Police party case and brought down the dead body and taken to JMCH for PM exam. After PM is over the body was handed over to us at about 7:00 PM and was cremated in the night. My son would

not have died if police have not assaulted and forced him to speak wrong statement about his involvement in the bomb blast case. If he was involved in the case he was to forward to jail. Police have illegally detained my son in police custody for more than 5 days and physically assaulted him.

Q. No. 1:- Your son was picked up by police from 22.12.2023 to 26.12.2023 and handed over to you during night time, what your son reported ?

Ans- he always reported that he was assaulted by SP, Mohanlal Meena, IPS and other officers and forced him to say his involvement in the bomb blast case and assault severely, but he did not agree to give false statement about his involvement.

Q. No.2:- what is opinion about his death ?

Ans- Due to police atrocity and inhuman torture my son had to commit suicide and SP Meena is guilty for the death of my son. My son was an innocent boy who was a cultivator and look after the family and the old ailing parents and now we are becoming helpless I want justice to take action against the guilty officers.
